Page 15	Error – Motion-Tracking Devices and/or Camera Devices – It is illegal for a person to possess or use in the field any electronic or camera device whose purpose is to scout the location of game animals or relay the information on a game animal’s location or movement during any Commission-adopted hunting season.	Correction – Motion-Tracking and/or Camera Devices – It is illegal for a person, while hunting, to possess any electronic motion-tracking device or mechanism that is designed to track the motion of a game animal and relay information on the animal’s movement to the hunter. A radio-tracking collar attached to a dog that is used by a hunter engaged in lawful hunting activities is not considered an illegal motion-tracking device.
Page 16	Error – Charles M. Russell (CMR) National Wildlife Refuge and U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Restricted Area should also include the UL Bend National Wildlife Refuge	Correction – Charles M. Russell (CMR) and UL Bend National Wildlife Refuges and U.S. Army Corps of Engineers
Page 34	Error – Hunting District 121, Elk permit 121-02 reads: 121-02: 20 permits. Only valid on private land, excluding Avista, Weyerhaeuser, Stoltze and Stimson Timber lands.	Correction – HD 121, Elk permit 121-02 should be: 121-02: 20 permits. Only valid on private land in the Heron Flats portion of HD 121 excluding Stimson Lumber Company and Avista land.
Page 39	Error – Hunting District 215, Elk B License 215-02 reads: 215-02: Unlimited. One per hunter. Must purchase before start of the general season. Secure access before purchasing. Not valid on National Forest Lands or Spotted Dog WMA. • Aug 15 - Feb 15 - Antlerless Elk.	Correction – HD 215, Elk 215-02 should be: 215-02: Unlimited. One per hunter. Must purchase before start of the general season. Secure access before purchasing. • Aug 15 - Oct 20 - Antlerless Elk. Only valid on private land. • Oct 21 - Feb 15 - Antlerless Elk. Not valid on National Forest Lands or Spotted Dog WMA.
