*Great Falls Hooked on Fishing, Not Drugs* will be hosting its annual "Camp Walleye." This is a kid's fishing camp open to both boys and girls who are familiar with outdoor activities, including fishing and other camping activities. It will consist of two boating sessions in which 2-3 campers will be fishing with a volunteer boat captain and co-captain.

This camp is an **ADULT SUPERVISED CAMP** and is limited to 50 applicants aged 11-17 years old.

- Where: Tiber Reservoir (meet at Ru's Tiber Marina Pavilion)
- When: Saturday, 13 August 2022

6:00 am - 10:00 pm (Drop off and pick up campers Walmart Parking Lot , Smelter Ave) --Bus will leave Walmart Parking Lot at 6 am and return at approximately 10pm \*All campers will leave/return via provided bus unless parents are at Tiber Reservoir\*

• Meals, and transportation from North Middle School to and from Tiber Reservoir will be provided

#### \*\*Cancellations must be received before July 20th\*\*

Life jackets will be available and are mandatory at all times the campers are on the water; however, if campers have their own life jacket they are encouraged to bring them.

Each camper is responsible for their own personal equipment (i.e. personal items and appropriate clothing for Montana's acclimate weather). Cell phones not advised as there is limited to no cellular service at Tiber Reservoir.

Camp Walleye is designed to provide an opportunity for our youth to learn boat safety, fishing etiquette, fish identification and experience fishing with veteran fishing captains. With this wonderful opportunity comes great responsibility; therefore, for the safety and enjoyment of everyone in attendance, the following are the Rules and Expectations for Camp Walleye. ALL campers will be expected to follow all the rules.

DISRESPECT, ILL-MANNERED AND/OR MISBEHAVIOR <u>WILL NOT BE TOLERATED</u> AND WILL BE GROUNDS FOR IMMEDIATE EXPULSION FROM CAMP.

PARENTS/GUARDIANS ARE RESPONSIBLE TO **IMMEDIATELY** PICK UP THEIR CAMPER UPON EXPULSION FROM TIBER RESERVIOR, AT <u>THEIR</u> OWN EXPENSE, AS CAMPER WILL NOT BE PERMITED TO TRAVEL OR INTERACT WITH CAMP WALLEYE CAMPERS AND/OR STAFF.

**Directions:** Read the following **<u>Rules and Expectations</u>** and <u>initial</u> each to acknowledge you have read and understand the Rules and Expectations and the consequences should infractions occur. Camper Initials Rule or Expectation Parent Initials

Camper(s) will at no time have weapons of any kind at Camp, <u>including, but</u> <u>not</u> <u>limited to, firearms and knives.</u> Additional_definitions of weapons will be determined by Camp Advisors. If weapons are brought to Camp Walleye, camper(s) will be immediately expelled.	
Camper(s) will at no time have <u>alcohol, tobacco, or other drugs</u> on Campgrounds. Any prescription drugs that campers need to take should be identified, and Camp Advisors should be notified. If alcohol, tobacco, or illegal drugs are found at Camp, the camper(s) will be immediately expelled.	
Camper(s) will refrain from using profanity during Camp Walleye if camper(s) use profanity while at Camp Walleye – they will be immediately expelled.	
<b>Fighting, hazing, harassment, intimidation, bullying</b> of other campers or camp staff is strictly prohibited at Camp and will not be tolerated. Should Camp Advisors determine that camper(s) is engaging in fighting, hazing, harassment, intimidation, or bullying, camper(s) will be immediately expelled.	
For safety purposes, camper(s) will be expected to listen to Camp Advisors and Boat Captains at all times. Should Camp Advisors feel that camper(s) are not in accordance with this expectation and that the safety of Boat Captains or other campers is at risk, camper(s) will be immediately expelled.	

Cell phones and other recording devices should be used with the approval of Camp Advisors. Misuse will be grounds for the immediate expulsion of the camper(s).	

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
